Bosa reports Electra nearly 90 percent sold

Bosa Development's 248-unit, 43-story Electra tower near downtown San Diego's bayfront is now nearly 90 percent sold and home to more than 220 families, according to CEO and President Nat Bosa. The residences are above three levels of underground parking.

Two-bedroom units, two townhomes and two penthouses, starting at \$2.175 million, are available. The two-bedroom units start at \$549,000, while the townhomes start at \$679,000. The tower offers a main floor social lounge with 60-foot ceilings, an illuminating skylight, and a fifth-floor exercise facility and sun deck, according to Sharon Tentilucci, Electra sales agent.
